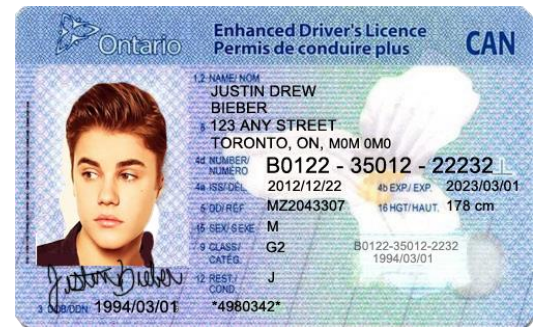

G2 Licence – 19 and Under

Between Midnight and 5 a.m. you can only drive with _____ passenger who is 19 or under in your car. This condition applies for the first 6 months of G2. After 6 months you can drive with up to 3 passengers who are 19 or under between midnight and 5 a.m. This condition does not apply if you have a fully licenced driver in the car (with 4+ years of driving experience) or if the passengers are immediate family members (e.g., a parent, brother or sister)
